Speaker: Susan Knight, UC, Irvine **Talk**: Understanding and Applying Why People Learn to the Level of Efficiency

Abstract: What do we know about how users learn their computer or other habits? Studies of how everyday habits are formed and are reinforced will be presented, including research on computer users' learning experiences. This research, grounded in social psychology and related theory, was framed in a consumer behavior (marketing) context, but draws from and applies to a wide variety of everyday experiences. Results suggest the key role of efficiency in computer and other habitual behaviors. Along the way, new insights for differentiating habitual from similar behaviors will be discussed.

Susan's Bio

Susan J. Knight received her M.B.A. (1992) and Ph.D. (1999) from U.C. Irvine's Graduate School of Management, and her B.A. in Biology from the College of Wooster. She worked in the medical field for many years as a medical technologist, toxicologist and project manager for a medical device company. Currently, she combines her experience and expertise in both academia and industry as a Corporate Relations Officer, fostering research and other relationships between industry and UCI. She represents UCI's Research and Graduate Studies, the Institute for Software Research, and the Institute for Genomics and Bioinformatics.
